Introduction

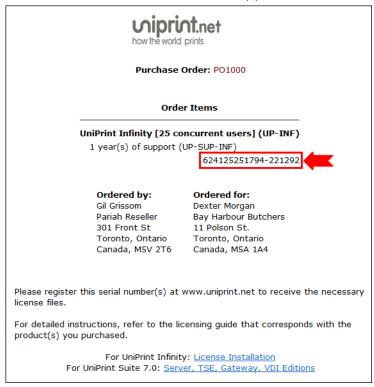
UniPrint Infinity is licensed on a per concurrent user basis and licenses are managed by the License Server component. The License Server component is installed on the Bridge by default. Upon purchasing UniPrint Infinity, an e-mail with a serial number will be sent to you. This serial number needs to be registered through our Web site (www.uniprint.net) before licenses can be issued.

This guide is designed to assist you with registering your serial number(s), applying licenses to your License Server and managing your UniPrint support contract.

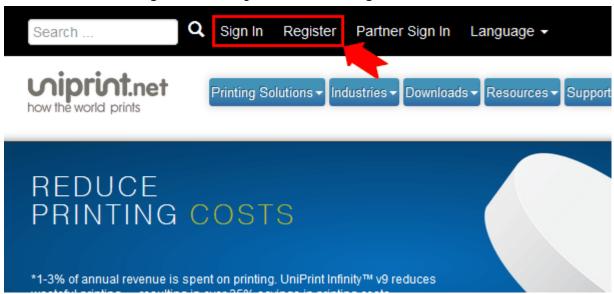
Registering Your Serial Number

Upon purchasing UniPrint Infinity, an e-mail with serial number(s) will be sent to you. To ensure that you receive this e-mail, make sure that your anti-spam software does not filter out e-mail from support@uniprint.net and sales@uniprint.net.

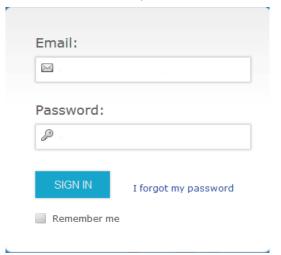
1. From the UniPrint Portal e-mail, take note of the serial number(s).



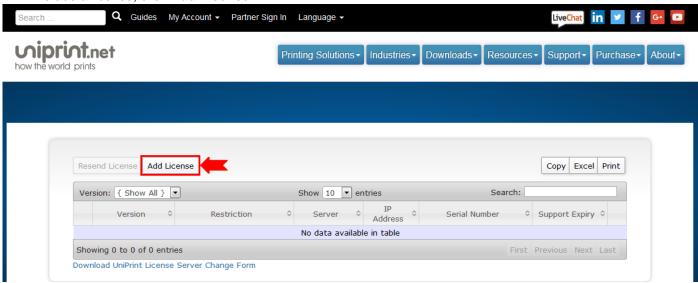
2. New customers are required to register through the UniPrint Web site, www.uniprint.net. Click **Register**, complete the form and then click **Register**. Returning customers, click **Sign In**.



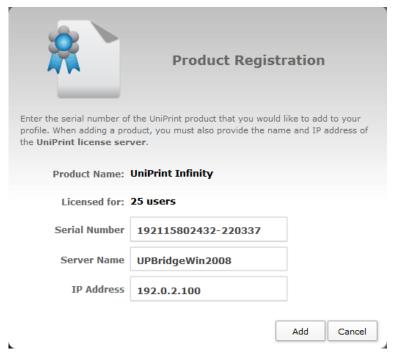
3. For Returning Users, enter your e-mail address and password and then click SIGN IN.



4. To add a license, click Add License



 Enter a Serial Number (from the e-mail), the UniPrint License Server Name and the UniPrint License Server IP Address, and then click Add.



Your License Management page will be updated and a license file will be sent to you via e-mail from support@uniprint.net. To ensure that this message is received, verify that anti-spam filters are not blocking messages from this e-mail address.

Applying the License File to UniPrint Infinity

After registering the serial number on www.uniprint.net, another e-mail from the UniPrint Support Team, support@uniprint.net, will be sent with your license file attached as a text file similar to the one below.

To Install the License Key:

Rename the attached TEXT file to ".reg" extension.

- Copy the key file to the server where the License Server component will be installed.
- Open the UniPrint Management Console and click the Add License button.
- 4. Browse to the license location and add the license.

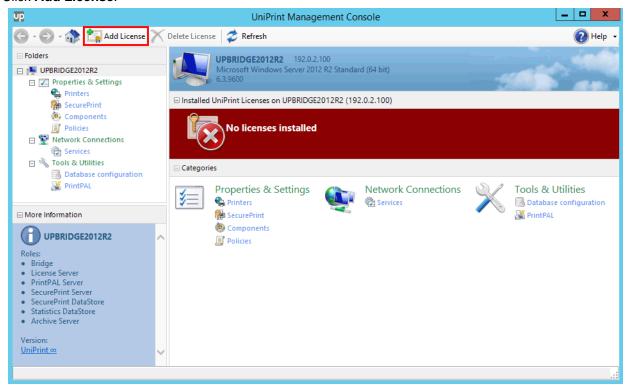

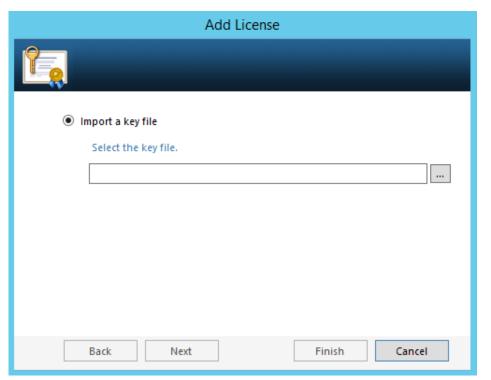

- 1. Save the attachment to a location that is accessible by the License Server. Typically, this file will be attached as [LicenseServerName].txt.
- 2. Rename the file extension from .txt to .reg.
- 3. On the License Server, click Start, All Programs, UniPrint Suite and then click UniPrint Management Console.

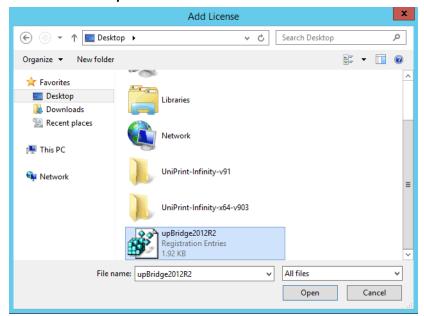
4. Click Add License.



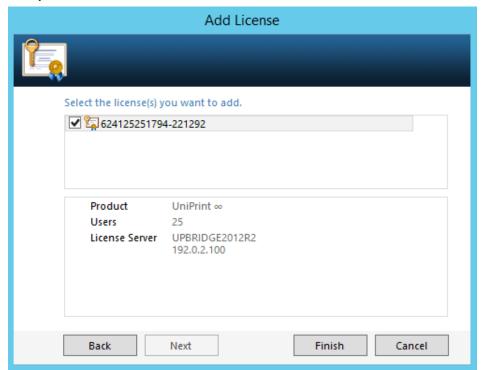
5. Click to browse for the UniPrint License file (*.reg).



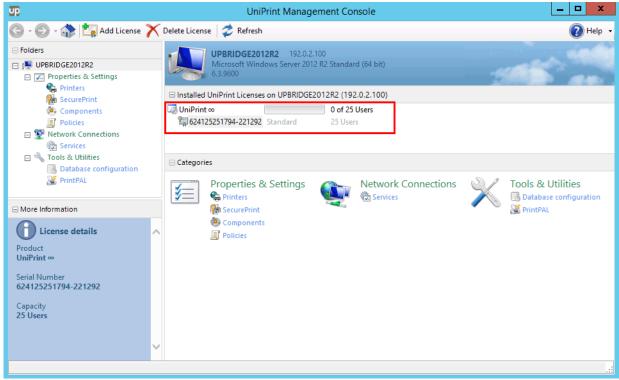
6. Click the license file and then click Open.



7. Select the license you want to add and then click **Finish**.



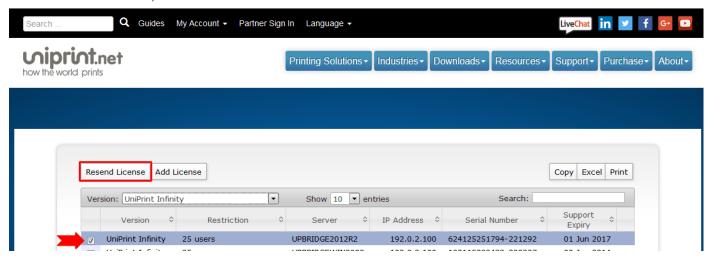
8. The license information should appear under the top banner.



Retrieving an Existing License File

You can have an existing license file resent to you at anytime.

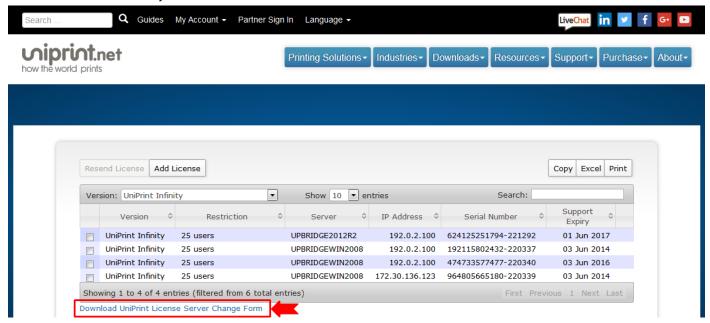
- 1. Sign in to your UniPrint.net account by visiting www.uniprint.net. Click **Sign In**. Enter your credentials and then click **SIGN IN**.
- 2. Beside the license, click to select the check box and then click **Resend License**.



The License file will be sent as an e-mail attachment. Apply the new license file on the appropriate UniPrint License Server.

Modifying an Existing License

If you wish to change UniPrint License Server information, click **Download UniPrint License Server Change Form** located under the list of licenses. Complete and submit this form to UniPrint Support (support@uniprint.net) and a new license file will be issued to you.



Updating Your User Profile
